






Figure 5. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature




Figure 7. Capacitance Variation




Figure 8. Gate-to-Source and




Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation vs. Gate Resistance




Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current




Figure 11. Safe Operating Area




Figure 12. I_{PEAK} vs. Time in Avalanche




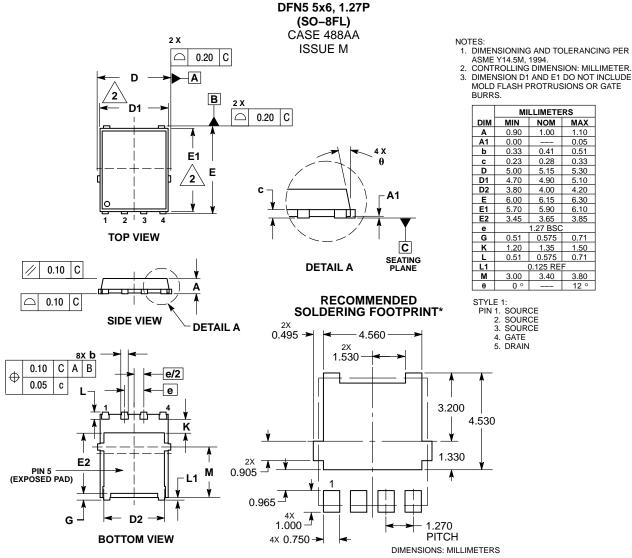
Figure 13. Thermal Characteristics
