Functional Description

The CY7C1041CV33 Automotive is a high performance CMOS static RAM organized as 262,144 words by 16 bits.


To write to the device, take Chip Enable (CE) and Write Enable (WE) inputs LOW. If Byte Low Enable (BLE) is LOW, then data from I/O pins (I/O $_0$ through I/O $_7$), is written into the location specified on the address pins (A $_0$ through A $_1$ 7). If Byte High Enable (BHE) is LOW, then data from I/O pins (I/O $_8$ through I/O $_1$ 5) is written into the location specified on the address pins (A $_0$ through A $_1$ 7).

To read from the device, take Chip Enable ($\overline{\text{CE}}$) and Output Enable ($\overline{\text{OE}}$) LOW while forcing the Write Enable (WE) HIGH. If Byte Low Enable (BLE) is LOW, then data from the memory location specified by the address pins appear on I/O₀ to I/O₇. If Byte High Enable (BHE) is LOW, then data from memory appears on I/O₈ to I/O₁₅. For more information, see the Truth Table on page 10 for a complete description of Read and Write modes.

The input and output pins (I/O $_0$ through I/O $_{15}$) are <u>placed</u> in a high impedance state when <u>the</u> device is des<u>elected</u> (CE HIGH), the outputs are <u>disabled</u> (OE HIGH), the BHE and <u>BLE</u> are <u>disabled</u> (BHE, BLE HIGH), or during a write operation (CE LOW and WE LOW).

For best practice recommendations, refer to the Cypress application note AN1064, SRAM System Guidelines.

Figure 1. 44-pin SOJ/TSOP II (Top View) [1]





Figure 2. 48-ball FBGA Pinout (Top View) [1]



Figure 4. Read Cycle No. 1 (Address Transition Controlled)^[10, 11]





Figure 5. Read Cycle No. 2 (OE Controlled)[11, 12]

Figure 6. Write Cycle No. 1 (CE Controlled)[13, 14]





Figure 7. Write Cycle No. 2 (BLE or BHE Controlled)







44 Lead (400 MIL) MOLDED SOJ



Figure 10. 44-pin Thin Small Outline Package Type II, 51-85087





