# With 5 V-Tolerant Inputs

The MC74LCX00 is a high performance, quad 2–input NAND gate operating from a 2.3 to 3.6 V supply. High impedance TTL compatible inputs significantly reduce current loading to input drivers while TTL compatible outputs offer improved switching noise performance. A  $V_{\rm I}$  specification of 5.5 V allows MC74LCX00 inputs to be safely driven from 5 V devices.

Current drive capability is 24 mA at the outputs.






SOIC-14 D SUFFIX CASE 751A






TSSOP-14 DT SUFFIX CASE 948G




Figure 1. Pinout: 14-Lead (Top View)




Figure 2. Logic Diagram






**WAVEFORM 1 - PROPAGATION DELAYS**

Figure 3. AC Waveforms







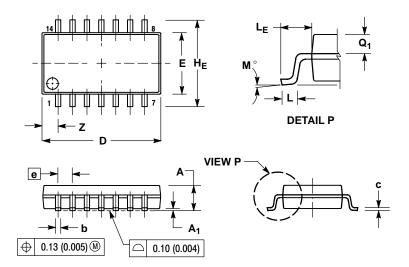
