### 1.1 General description

SiliconMAX standard level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product is designed and qualified for use in computing, communications, consumer and industrial applications only.







**Fig 1.** Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature




$$I_{der} = \frac{I_D}{I_D(25^\circ C)} \times 100 \%$$

**Fig 3.** Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage








Fig 6. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 8. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values




Fig 9. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 10. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature






Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





**Fig 12. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**





**Fig 14. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values**




